It is **CRITICAL** to attend your **eviction hearing** to protect your rights. At court you will learn about the status of your rental assistance application, get connected to Legal Aid Attorneys and resources, and seek more time to resolve matters with your landlord.

Court is held virtually on Zoom or in person.

2. CALL LEGAL AID:

(502) 584-1254

Legal Aid is a free service to advise you of your legal rights and represent you in eviction court. If you're lower-income and have a child living in your home, **you may be guaranteed legal representation.**

4. MOVING OUT?

It remains **CRITICAL** to attend your eviction hearing to keep a judgment off your record.

The Louisville Urban League deposit assistance program will pay for a deposit and the first 2 months of rent:

- A.** Find, apply, and be approved for new housing.
- B.** If approved, note your new landlord's name, number, and address.

- C. Caution:** The Louisville Urban League deposit program has now closed and is no longer accepting new applications.
